- Remember to check messages. These appear on the first screen when your child logs in. Sometimes we need to use messages to help direct and support your child and it is important that they read them. Keep an eye out for a weekly roundup from the class teacher too.
- Send us a message. There is always a teacher available throughout the school day. So if you need to ask us a question or if our instructions aren't clear enough, please get in touch.
