- If parents want to see work in advance, you can do this by logging into eSchools using your parent log in details. I know this has been a big help to some parents who are working from home.
- Try to **check** their work briefly before **submitting** to ensure it has been completed and help them to photograph and **attach** the correct documents when needed.
- Remember to read our comments. Every piece of work will receive a
  comment from the teacher giving praise/areas for improvement. To do this,
  return to the 'homework handed in' section of homework and click on work
  that is tagged as 'marked'. Sometimes there may be a nice success card
  surprise waiting!
- Remember to check messages. These appear on the first screen when your child logs in. Sometimes we need to use messages to help direct and support your child and it is important that they read them.
- You can send us a message too. There is always a teacher available throughout the school day. So if you need to ask us a question or if our instructions aren't clear enough, please get in touch.
