Covid-19 Test and Trace

Just a reminder re reporting symptoms after school closes tonight.

If your child develops symptoms up to and including Sunday 28th March which results in a positive test then you must inform us.

Please inform us of a positive test via email - tanfieldlea@durhamlearning.net

Please title the email 'Positive Test Result' and include the following information:

If I receive an email informing me of a positive test result I will contact Public Health and may have to ring you for further information. If I do ring you, the number will come up on your phone as 'Caller ID Unknown'. Please answer this.

If your child develops coronavirus symptoms from Monday 29th March onwards, they must be tested and, if positive, follow the advice of Test and Trace. **You do not need to inform the school of any symptoms which occur from Monday 29th March onwards.**

I will check the school email address (tanfieldlea@durhamlearning.net) every morning at 9 a.m. up to and including Thursday 1st April. After that, the email address will not be checked as any test results from children who had symptoms up to and including Sunday 28th March will have been received by then.

It is crucial that all parents check their emails daily as if we do have a positive case I will have to contact the parents of all children who have been in contact with the child who has tested positive. Thank you.
