

Dear Parents 19th January 2022

As you will remember, it's Talent Show time when the children suddenly start telling jokes, doing magic tricks, singing and dancing. Basically when they show how talented they are. This year, as last year, we have decided to hold our Talent Show virtually due to the ongoing situation regarding the virus.

We'd like to invite all children from **Y2 to Y6** to share their talent with us. Auditions will take place within classes during the **week beginning 24**th **January 2022**. Two acts will be chosen from each class to then perform afterschool, where their act will be videoed. Children who are chosen will receive a letter about this. Children can show individual talents or work as part of a group no larger than 4. **If working as a group, children must be from the same class.**

Ways to enter:

1. If your Talent can not be shown in class, for example horse riding, skateboarding, gymnastics please send a video to your class teacher. The act needs to be recorded. It should be no more than 90 seconds in length. No names should be used. Once the video has been checked by an adult *upload* it to the child's eSchools account via a message.

Home video entries will be accepted up to and including Monday 24th January.

2. If you are singing, dancing, telling jokes please have your talent act ready to perform in class for week beginning 24th January.

During this week, acts and videos from home will be shared in class and teachers will choose 2 to feature in our final Talent Show. The final Talent Show video will then be shared via our school YouTube channel on **Wednesday 9**Th **February.**

We won't be selecting winners this time, we'll just be enjoying the performances.

Hopefully the children will enjoy taking part and we look forward to seeing all their Talents.
