**EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO BEAMISH  
MUSEUM - Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022**



Dear Parent,

The children in Years 3 and 4 have the opportunity to visit Beamish Museum on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022** to link in with our topic all about our area and the life of Tommy Armstrong, 'Pitman Poet'. During the visit children will have the opportunity to re-enact the 'Oakie's Evictions'. They will access activities and areas of the Museum not open to the general public.

There is a cost of £6.50 to cover the entry fee and special activities throughout the day plus the cost of the bus, the **total cost will be £13**.

Most parents paid for the Northern Stage visit in December which did not take place and, as you have already been informed, we have managed to secure a refund for all costs incurred for this. This means that the majority of parents have already paid £12 and so for them we are asking for an additional voluntary contribution of £1 for this visit. We'd like this contribution to be paid in cash. Please send £1 in a named envelope.

For those parents who had not contributed towards the theatre visit, we will send a separate email indicating what your voluntary contribution is.

The children will be spending sometime outside so please ensure your child is suitably dressed for the weather that day by bringing a waterproof coat with them - normal school uniform should be worn. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am returning back to school before the end of the school day. As this is an all day trip your child will **require a packed lunch** on that day - children currently receiving a free school meal will be provided with a school packed lunch. Please feel free to supplement this with a packet of crisps and a chocolate biscuit if you wish. Please ensure you provide your child with an extra bottle of water (no fizzy drinks) to drink throughout the day - no glass bottles please.

Please make the voluntary contribution by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022 so we can confirm that the visit can take place.
