Once he returned to Hoffenheim, Steve Bruce, Newcastle's (ex) manager signed the man for 40 million which was at the time, a transfer record for Newcastle. He has went on to achieve great things with the club. He has played 122 games and has scored 12 goals which is still a rising count. His skill has improved beyond imagination thanks to Eddie Howe and his coaching staff.

How to Draw Wednesday Addams!!By Holly Taylor

If you are a Wednesday Addams FAN this is the one for you!!!! Read on to learn how to draw her!

Step 1(the face):

To draw the face, you start off with the oval. You now do a cross in the oval (use a pencil(lightly))) and 2 other lines (under each other) for the mouth and the nose!

Now to draw the eyes. Draw two ovals on the line nearest to the top – shade in grey-. Now draw a semicircle connected too the lined you just drawn. Then

put dots in the semi-circle for a pupil. Next, the nose! Draw two lines going down (symmetrical (in-between the eyes)) with three lines like on the picture of her (at the top)-. Now for the mouth! Draw a curve on the bottom of the last line for the bottom lip. Then draw a M with two lines (going of the start and end of the M). rub out any unwanted lines! Now to draw the ears. Draw a curve connected to the sides of the face.

Step 2 (the hair):



Well done you have now drawn Wednesday Addams. At the top of her head (above her eyes), draw a bunch of uneven lines for her bangs. To draw her plats, just draw curves coming down and connect them with another bunch of curves. To draw her hairline, draw a wonky line and draw lines coming off it.

Step 3 (her shoulders, neck, clothes and colour (finally))

To draw her neck, from the point of her eves – nearest to her ears- go down with your fingers- and draw her neck coming off her face. To do the collar, of her clothes draw two diagonal lines coming off her neck. Then draw 2 different lines (going the other way) and connect at the centre. For the shoulders draw a diagonal line going like the look of shoulders, obviously, and onto the edges of the page. Now colour in the traditional black and white!!!!!!

Tuesday:

Wednesday:
