The plan is as follows:

## **Monday**

Please ensure your child has brought in any costume they need ready for the dress rehearsal this afternoon. Parents who have been invited to the dress rehearsal please arrive at 1:15 (come to the main entrance).

Tickets for the Tuesday performance will be sent out today.

## ***Leavers' Tea***

This will take place at school from 4:15 until 5:45.
